Healy moved to York, Maine, in fifth grade, where he met his future wife, Ann Bowen Healy, when she moved to town in eighth grade. The two graduated from York High in 1992. By then, he had already found his niche.

He followed his older brother Patrick into the world of the theater crew. While Patrick was drawn to sound and house management — and today is assistant head of audio at Radio City Music Hall just down the road — Healy said he liked the “hands on aspect” of lighting."
